

'Get Qualified' courses – up to Level 2

We have changed the way that we are supporting learners who wish to enrol onto a course up to Level 2. These courses will have standard concessionary rates as well as a new rate for those who are employed but earning less than

£17,000 per year (U17K). This means that fees will be more affordable for learners who wish to improve their skills while working. Those wishing to take advantage of this new rate will need to provide us with evidence.

How do I Apply for Level 3 Accredited Courses?

The government have changed the way that they are supporting learners who wish to enrol onto a level 3 course and are over 24 years of age. This means that fees will be more expensive than in previous years for learners who are over 24 years of age.

If you are unable to pay the new fees, then the government has created a new 24+ Advanced Learner Loan which can help you to pay your tuition fees.

The loan is easy to apply for, your household income is not taken into account and there is no credit check. You only start to repay the loan when your income is over £21,000 a year.

Step 1: To enrol on a level 3 course you will need to attend an assessment session and successfully complete the 'Prepare for' course.

Step 2: Once you have successfully completed the Prepare For course and been offered a place on the Level 3 course you will be provided with information on the options to fund your course. These include taking an Advanced Learner Loan or paying for your course in two instalments.
